FUNDING SCHOLARSHIPS

Pig on the Pond Community Festival, presented by APC Roofing and the City of Clermont, began 26 years ago as a small afternoon barbecue competition. The purpose then, as it is today, was to raise funds for scholarships to help local students in need of financial assistance who dreamed of attending college. With the support of hundreds of volunteers, the Community Foundation of South Lake, and the unflagging dedication of Cheryl Fishel, the event grew into a three-day, signature event for the greater Clermont area. It is now the largest-attended festival in South Lake and has been voted one of Central Florida's most popular festivals.

Pig on the Pond is hosted by Project Scholars, a 501(c)(3) non-profit. The organization is led by a dedicated volunteer board of directors with a heart for the South Lake community. Project Scholars has raised and distributed over \$400,000 in scholarships for 400+ South Lake County students.


SHUTTLE SCHEDULE



- the entire event. Retractable leashes must be at 5ft max, and no choke, pronged or spiked collars are allowed.
- 4. Please be sure your pet has been exposed to noisy environments, costumes, other animals or larger crowds of people. If not, your pet may become afraid.
- 5. All pets must have current registration tags from the city of residence and wearing ID tags.
- 6. All pets must be current on all vaccinations. Your vet can supply this information.
- 7. Owner must appropriately dispose of their dog's fecal matter. Be courteous to other guests and clean up your pet's accident.
- 8. Outside food (pet or human) is not allowed in the show area.
- 9. Lastly, have fun!
